AMENDMEN

Assembly Amendment

Provided an additional \$1.4 million GPR in FY 2019-20 and \$2.1 million GPR in FY 2020-21 and an additional 34.95 GPR Assistant District Attorney positions.

Start date for new positions would be October 1, 2019.

Total number of new Assistant District Attorney positions across Wisconsin will be 64.95.

Department of Military Affairs

Action by the Joint Finance Committee

- The Committee took no action on the Department of Military Affairs.
 - DMA 911 appropriation would be base level funding from the 2017-19 budget.
 - Did not address requirement to lapse unused funds for the creation of a state-wide digital 911 network (ESInet). DMA has a balance of \$6.3 million for Next Generation 911.
 - DMA would not have the necessary funds to stay on track for the ESInet creation.

Assembly Amendment

- DMA still required to lapse unused funds (\$6.3 million)
- Amendment provides \$19.7 million in FY 2019-20 and can be used through FY 2020-21. At the end of FY 2020-21, unused funds would again be lapsed back to the Police and Fire Protection Fund.
- \$0 appropriated in FY 2020-21 which means that DMAs base funding for the ESInet will be \$0 thus requiring the Department to make a formal request in the next budget for ongoing funding.



Assembly Bill 251

- AB 251 was approved by both houses of the legislature and now awaits action from the Governor.
- Relates to third-party online sellers and requires the collection and remittance of state and local sales taxes.
 - Change will increase county sales tax revenues by approximately \$3.6 million in state fiscal year 20 and \$5.4 million in state fiscal year 21
- WCA worked with a coalition of other stakeholders to support this legislation aimed at leveling the playing field between online and brick and mortar retailers.
