1 AUTHORIZING ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH AGENT STATUS 2 RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE SAWYER COUNTY HEALTH DEPARTMENT TO BECOME AN ENVIRONMENTAL 3 HEALTH AGENT FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE, TRADE AND CONSUMER PROTECTION 4 WHEREAS, State statute 97.615 (2)(am) and 97.41 (1m) states the department may enter into a written 5 agreement with the local health department which designates the local health department as the agent of the 6 Department of Agriculture, Trade, and Consumer Protection for issuing licenses and making investigations or 7 inspections; and 8 WHEREAS, Chapter ATCP 74, Subchapter I, ATCP 74.01 of the Administrative Code authorizes issuing licenses to 9 and investigations or inspections of hotels, motels, and tourist rooming houses (ATCP 72), restaurants (ATCP 75), 10 bed and breakfasts (ATCP 73), campgrounds and camping resorts (ATCP 79), recreational and educations camps 11 (ATCP 78), mobile home parks (SPS 326), public swimming pools (ATCP 78), and vending machine operations 12 13 (ATCP 75); and WHEREAS, Chapter ATCP 74, Subchapter II, ATCP 74.21 of the Administrative Code authorizes issuing licenses to 14 and investigations or inspections of retail food establishments (Chapter ATCP 75); and 15 WHEREAS, currently not all of the 600+ Sawyer County establishments are being inspected annually, therefore, 16 the State is encouraging counties to become agents for the State; and 17 WHEREAS, Sawyer County relies heavily on, and takes pride in its tourism industry, and has a strong desire to 18 ensure everyone's safety by establishing food and sanitation standards that provide protection for our local 19 residents as well as our tourist based economy; and 20 WHEREAS, food and water security and safety are a significant concern as contaminated food and water have 21 been identified and linked with major outbreaks of illnesses including outbreaks associated with e. coli, 22 cryptosporidium, salmonella, and other organisms; and 23 WHEREAS, a rapid and coordinated environmental health response is required to control the spread of food 24 borne illnesses; and 25 WHEREAS, Sawyer County Health Department environmental health professionals can establish a growing, 26 working relationship with local facilities to answer any questions and work together in solving operational 27 issues; and 28 WHEREAS, Sawyer County Health Department environmental health professionals are also valuable resources 29 for area operator questions in the area of lead, radon, mold, asbestos, and mercury; and 30 WHEREAS, the annual license fees generated from these inspections will sustain this program and other funding 31 sources will be explored to help support this program; and 32 WHEREAS, Sawyer County has an opportunity to improve the efficiency and cost effectiveness of the 33 Environmental Health program, expand services, and shorten response times, as well as maintain capacity for 34 public health emergencies; and 35
