1 "	The process used to develop the UW-Cooperative Extension Multi-County
2 3	Reorganization plan was flawed and provided little opportunity for meaningful consideration of county concerns. The proposed plan reduces flexibility, decreases local
4	relevance, and removes accountability to local elected officials, partners, and participants.
5	The proposed plan jeopardizes the partnership between the UW-System and Wisconsin
6	counties, a partnership built on communication, collaboration, and engagement.

8	The current Cooperative Extension System has a proven track record of success for more
9	than 100 years as a single county based model for governance, locally set levy
10	contribution and county determined educational programming priorities under the
11	oversight of each County Extension Education Committee designated by the elected
12	county board.
13	
14	The reorganization plan imposes drastic changes to the current UW Extension System.
15	The reduction target allocated by the plan to Cooperative Extension of \$1.2 million
16	annually does not justify the complete dismantling of the current County-Based
17	Cooperative Extension system when there are multiple options to address the budget
18	shortfall.
19	
20	The reorganization plan eliminates 80 local faculty education positions, a reduction of
21	nearly 50% in direct education staff, while adding an unnecessary bureaucratic layer of at
22	least 18 "area-leader-director" positions who will not be accountable to local elected
23	officials, community partners, program priorities, community needs, volunteers, funders
24	or participants. Wisconsin counties are unlikely to continue the current level of county
25	tax levy support in future years if direct educational services are significantly decreased,
26	thereby making the proposed reorganization plan financially unstable.

28	NOW THEREFORE, the undersigned members of the Agriculture, Extension Education, Zoning
29	& Land Conservation Committee and the Legislative/Audit & Human Resources Committee
30	recommend adoption of the following resolution.
31	BE IT RESOLVED, that the Outagamie County Board of Supervisors hereby oppose the UW-
32	Cooperative Extension Multi-County Reorganization Plan approved by Chancellor Sandeen, and
33	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Outagamie County Board of Supervisors calls upon

University System President Ray Cross and the UW-Board of Regents to direct the Chancellor of the

1	UW Colleges and UW Cooperative Extension to retract all portions of the plan imposing a multi-county			
2	system on county/tribal extension offices and engage counties/tribes as equal partners to consider			
3	individual county options to address their share of the \$1.2 million reduction target, while maintaining			
4	the current single county extension system, and			
5	BE IT STILL FURTHER RESOLVED, Outagamie County is not willing to continue providing			
6	local tax levy funding at the current level if direct educational faculty services are decreased as			
7	described in the plan while eliminating accountability to the County Extension Education Committee			
8	and the County Board, and			
9	BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that the Outagamie County Clerk be directed to forward a copy			
10	of this resolution to the Outagamie County UW Extension Director, the Outagamie County Executive,			
11	all 72 Wisconsin counties, Wisconsin Counties Association, President Ray Cross and the Board of			
12	Regents, and the Outagamie County Lobbyist for distribution to the Legislature and Governor.
